A new Legend and copies of individual maps with new information sheets were distributed to the Block Captains. Eight individuals attended the meeting.

Jeanna Roush is the new Block Captain for the **east side of E Knighthood**. Thanks, Jeanna.

Jon Paxton CCSO Community Programs Planner discussed fire prevention, OHV unlawful riding and brought materials for us to hand out. **Please remember SFE streets are county roads and all vehicle laws apply.**

Assistant Fire Chief Matt McDowell indicated the Fire Department will be offering help with property assessment and lot preparation. **There is a very high risk for fire this year. Are you ready? Is your GO BAG ready?**

Matt and John are patrolling the neighborhood twice a day. We discussed residents placing a window sign reading **I'M OK** or **I'M NOT OK** when we have snow that prevents your getting out of the house and/or yard when you need help.

Our new Fire Chief John Moede previously mentioned to Mary that Home Depot will offer discounts on smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors and fire extinguishers for residents of our neighborhood. Contact John for further details.

Kathie Krushinsky indicated there will be a Sign-up Sheet at the May 29 Pancake Breakfast for manning the cinder pit. Currently the schedule shows dates between May 8 and July 10. Kathie will be working on expanding these dates. There will be READY-SET-GO information door hangers, HOV safety brochures and other information available at the breakfast also.
