

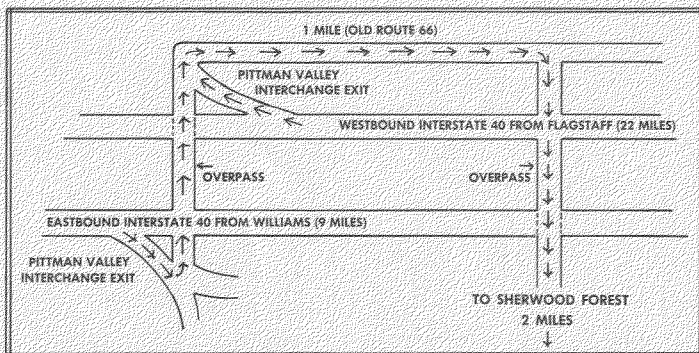

HOW TO GET TO SHERWOOD FOREST FROM FLAGSTAFF AND WILLIAMS



From Flagstaff: Go West on U.S. Highway 66 and new U.S. Interstate Highway 40 for 22 miles. Turn right off freeway at Pittman Valley Interchange. Follow signs around loop of old U.S. Highway 66 for 1 mile to road leading South over freeway to Sherwood Forest.

From Williams: Go East on new U.S. Interstate Highway 40 for 9 miles. Turn right off freeway at Pittman Valley Interchange. Then turn left on road leading North over freeway to old U.S. Highway 66. Go East 1 mile on old Highway 66 to road leading South over freeway to Sherwood Forest. Watch for signs.
