Five Block Captains and two neighbors met at the Sherwood Forest Fire Station at 7:00 p.m. on July 19, 2018.

It was noted that there were no incidents we were aware of since the last meeting. Jack & Sue Hadley found a dead bat in their home upon returning this summer. Jack gave us the following information:

- Sherwood Forest is in the western end of the Coconino County bat migration pattern.
- **If you find a dead animal in your home, call Animal Control at (928) 679-8756 before you stay inside.** Possible rabies would require shots.
- Rabies is passed through saliva.
- Flying erratically during the daytime is evidence of a rabid bat.
