Jon Paxton, Coconino County Sheriff's Office Community Programs Planner and Public Information Officer updated us on recent events in the county. He indicated a verdict had been reached in the Barnett case and later let us know the verdict was guilty.

It was noted that Code Red (Coconino.AZ.Gov/ReadyCoconino) and Ready-Set-Go (coconino.az.gov/207/Emergency-Management) are two separate emergency alert systems that need to be updated with your current information.

Although Wayne Marx, Sherwood Forest Estates District Fire Chief, planned to talk about the recent thefts at the fire station, he was unable to attend.

Kathie Krushinsky talked about the new Welcome Wagon packets. We requested that the list of Community Resources be shared with us all.
