Prevent burglaries by calling the **Sheriff's Department (928.635.4487 and say you are from Sherwood Forest Estates)** about any strange people walking or vehicles driving through the neighborhood. If your dog is barking, check it out.

**In case your home has been broken into, don't touch anything, move or rearrange anything and back out.**

**Be mindful of foot prints and tire tracks.** Crimes can be reported anonymously by calling **Crime Stoppers at 928.774.6111.**

**Always call 911 in case of medical or life threatening emergency.** Say you are from Sherwood Forest Estates.
